Journeys between 1988 & 2001

Jan 1988-Apr'99: Asia for 15 months; India (6 mths); 3 months in the north and 3 months in the south. Pakistan (2 mths); Hindu Kush mountains, Skardu & Karrakorum mountains, Peshawar, Chitral to Gilgit over the Shundur Pass. Nepal (1 1/2 mths) Thailand (3 mths) Hong Kong (2 weeks) China (3 mths) including Kashgar Sunday Market, Xinjiang. Tibet during riots and Beijing just before Tiananmen Square uprising squashed. Trans-Siberian back to Berlin from Beijing, through the then crumbling Soviet Block, via Moscow and Red Square.

Aug 1990: India; Kullu Valley in Himachal Pradesh, over the Rothang pass through Zanskar to Ladakh.

Aug 1991: Morocco; Tangiers Medina/Old town, Fez & the Rif Mountains.

Aug 1993: Trans-Siberian Express from Europe to Beijing; Then To Kashgar, again, in Xinjiang. Via Xian,

over the Karakorum mountains via the Khunjerab pass to Hunza Valley, in Pakistan. Ended at

Lahore for outbreak of the Monsoon.

March 1994: India; Official Photographer for Muzaffar Ali film shoot: Kotwara, UP & B & W village life.

Delhi Sadhus; Tiger Baba & Madhu Sudan, Sufi/Baul Musician from Calcutta/Bengal.

July 1994: Mongolia; Nada Music Tour of Mongolia: Ulaan Baatar to Chandeman Sum near the Altai

Mountains in the West of Mongolia. Khoomii singing. I stayed on for a month visiting Nomad families and collecting atmospheric & photojournalistic material.
